Notice of Requirement for a new designation: Drury South Interchange Connections (NoR 5)

Notice of Requirement

Auckland Council has received a notice of requirement for a new designation from NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) as the Requiring Authority, for State Highway 1 (SH1) improvements and associated infrastructure.

The requirement is for a new state highway to be constructed either side of the proposed Drury South Interchange to provide direct transport connections between State Highway 1 (SH1) and Maketu Road (to the east) and Great South Road (to the west), to enable the Requiring Authority to support regional growth through the improvement of safety, functionality, and resilience of the existing transport corridor.

The site to which the requirement applies is as follows: between Great South Road and Maketu Road at Drury South.

Making a submission on the notice of requirement

Any person or organisation may make a submission on the notice of requirement, but a person who is a trade competitor of the requiring authority may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that –

- (a) Adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
