#### Proposed Rezoning of Part of Shepherds Park Cresta Ave, Beach Haven.



Submission Date 21st March 2024

Beach Haven Bowling Club is an Incorporated Society actively and very successfully providing Lawn Bowling facilities not only to the communities of Beach Haven & Birkdale areas, but also to other adjacent suburbs.

Our Club Members have expressed concerns regarding the proposed Change of Zone required for the construction of a Marae and ancillary buildings and raised queries regarding the project. These concerns are as follows:-

- The lack of publicly available information regarding further development of a viable proposal despite the fact that it was largely supported in principle at one or two public meetings 5 or 6 years ago. A large amount of work must have transpired since then for the proposal none of which appears to be in the public domain.
- 2. What are the variations between the current Recreation Zone and the existing Treaty Settlement Land definitions and the proposed Chapter H27 Zoning and why they are required for the operation of a Marae complex as proposed.
- 3. Given the scale of the proposed buildings and the inevitable impact of increased vehicle and foot traffic, has due process been undertaken to ensure that the finished project will not adversely affect the surrounding environment, members of the public and established sports clubs of Shepherds Park like ourselves.
- 4. We understand that part of the application for rezoning requirements is that the applicant must present a viable 10 year plan for stand-alone financial operation of the complex. If the application is approved but the Marae governing body fails in its duty, H27 would allow a wide range of alternative usages, some of which would be detrimental to the amenities enjoyed by other users of the park. What steps are being taken to mitigate such effects.

Until we have a more comprehensive understanding of the long-term aims of the Marae Committee and Auckland City Council, we do not support the proposed plan changes.
