- 1 P2W Services Limited ('**P2W**') wishes, pursuant to s 274 of the Act to be party to the appeal by the Appellant on the Respondents decision confirming Notice of Requirement 1 Warkworth: Northern Public Transport Hub and Western Link North ('NoR 1').
- 2 P2W made a submission (dated 7 July 2023) on NoR 1.
- 3 P2W is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Act.
- 4 P2W is interested in all of the matters in this appeal.
- In particular, P2W is interested in the Appellant's relief that seeks access from its land onto the local road that serves the Public Transport Hub, including:
 - a A new condition is added to NOR1 to provide for vehicular access between the Appellant's land and the Western Link Road; or
 - b Alternatively, that the 'Additional Intersection Condition' is amended to include an obligation to provide for vehicular access between the Appellant's land and the Western Link Road.
- P2W opposes the relief sought by the Appellant to the extent that it adversely impacts the operation of, and safety and efficiency of the Old SH1/Western Link, and the Western Link North/Public Transport Hub intersections. The relief sought may impact the performance of the Western Link/Public Transport Hub intersection, which has not been assessed by the Applicant, and the effects are uncertain. If the performance of the Western Link North/Public Transport Hub intersection is poor due to the level of turning traffic volumes, flow-on effects may impact the function of Old SH1.
- P2W agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
