- The Appellant appeals Auckland Transport's (AT) decision in respect of NOR 2 –
 Woodcocks Road West Upgrade North (NOR 2).
- 2. The Appellant made a submission in respect of NOR 2. The Appellant received notice of the decision on 12 July 2024. The decision was made by the Respondent, AT. The Appellant is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- The decision appealed is the decision by AT to accept the decision to confirm NOR
 and accept in part and reject in part the consent authority's recommendations
 on conditions in respect of NOR 2.
- 4. The site or place to which NOR 2 applies is Woodcocks Road west from its intersection with Póhuehue Road including traversing parts of the property the Appellant has an interest in.
- 5. The reasons for the appeal include:
 - a. The extent of the NOR 2, particularly as it affects land the Appellant has an interest in, is not reasonably necessary for achieving the objectives of the requiring authority for which the designation was sought;
 - b. There has been inadequate consideration of alternative designation boundaries (where it traverses the property the Appellant has an interest in) which better reflect:
 - i. the objectives of the requiring authority;
 - ii. the relevant planning documents guiding the growth of Warkworth, including the Future Development Strategy (FDS), and Warkworth Structure Plan (WSP); and
 - iii. reduce the adverse environmental effects of NOR 2;
 - c. The designation in its current form is not in keeping with Part 2 of the RMA and the relevant planning documents including the Auckland Council's FDS and WSP.
 - d. The length of the lapse period is not in keeping with the principles of sustainable management, Part 2 of the RMA and/or the relevant planning documents guiding the growth of Warkworth, including the Future Development Strategy (FDS), and Warkworth Structure Plan (WSP).
- 6. The Appellant seeks the following relief:

- a. The cancellation of the NOR 2;
- b. In the alternative to cancellation of NOR 2, amendment of its boundaries to reduce the land required from the property Appellant has an interest in;
- c. Any other relief or amendments consequential on granting the relief sought in sub-paragraphs a. and b. above.
- d. In the event the Court decides to confirm NOR 2 on its current alignment or otherwise, reduce the lapse date of the designation to 10 years;
- 7. I attach the following documents to this notice:
 - a. a list of names and addresses of submitters to be served with a copy of this notice.
 - b. a copy of the Appellant's submission.
- 8. A copy of AT's decision being appealed will be filed with the Court. Auckland Council will also be served with a copy of this notice.
- 9. The Appellant agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution steps in relation to these proceedings.
