Context is important



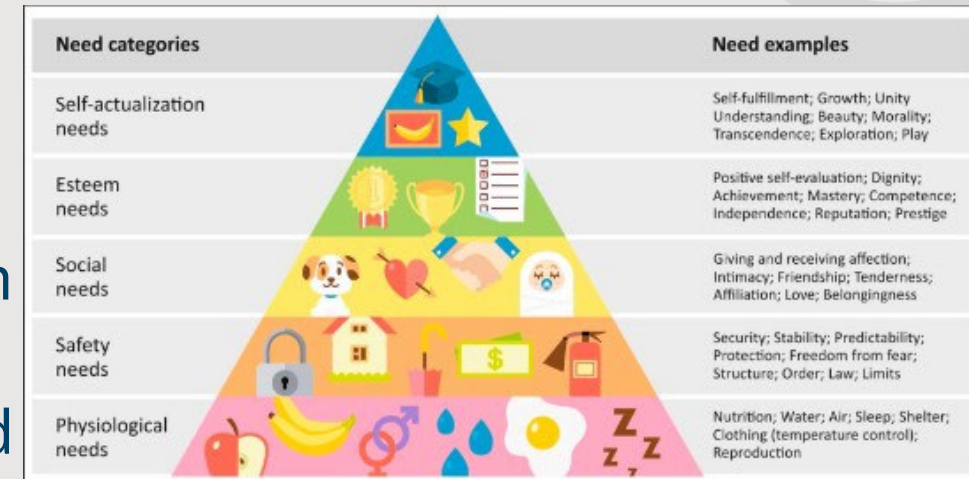
Wider Context

There have been many conversations around Bays in Action

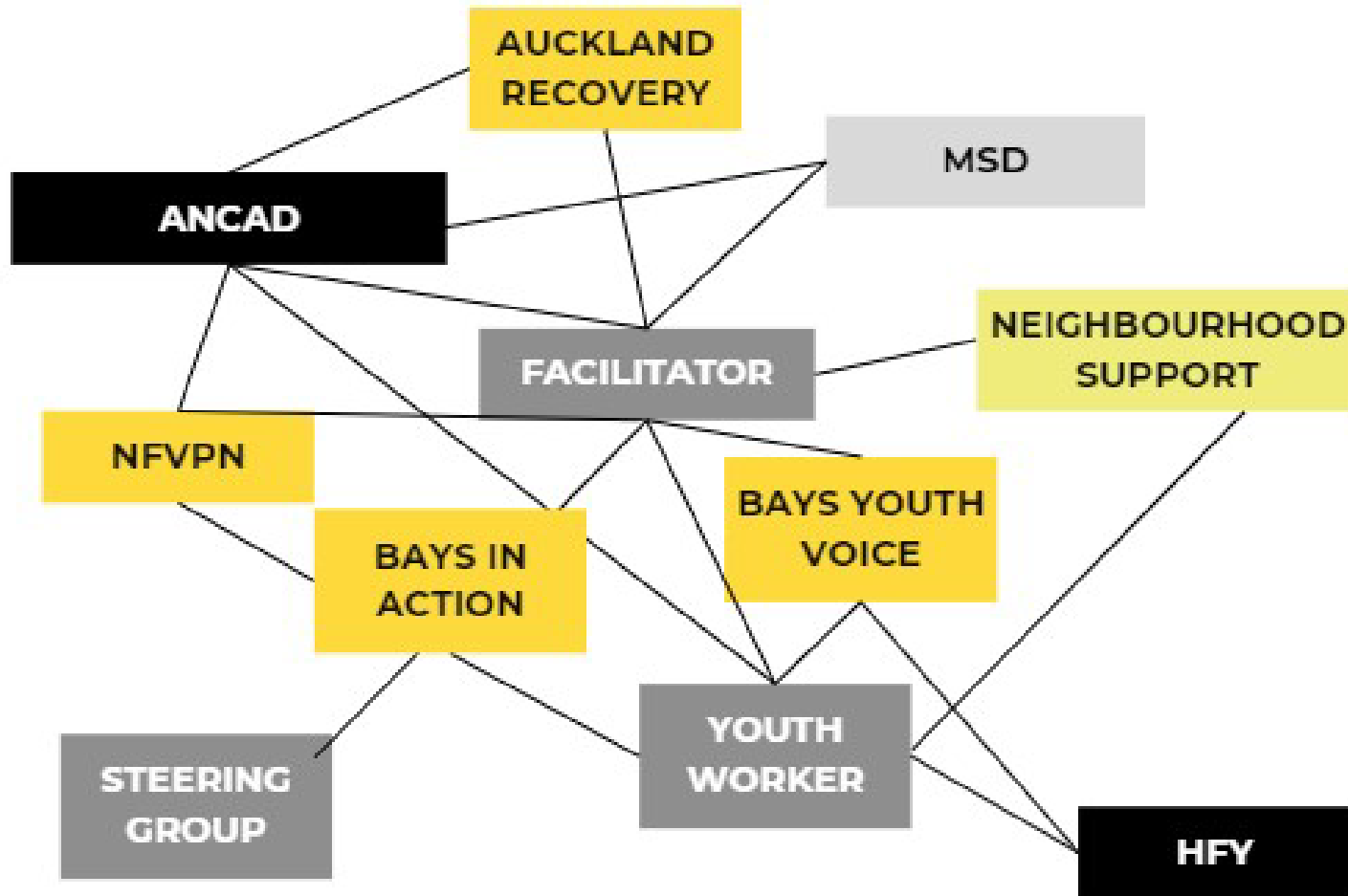
- Two local board members regularly attend the Bays in Action meetings and enjoy those meetings.

- This is about getting a clear picture – and putting the community and young people at the centre.






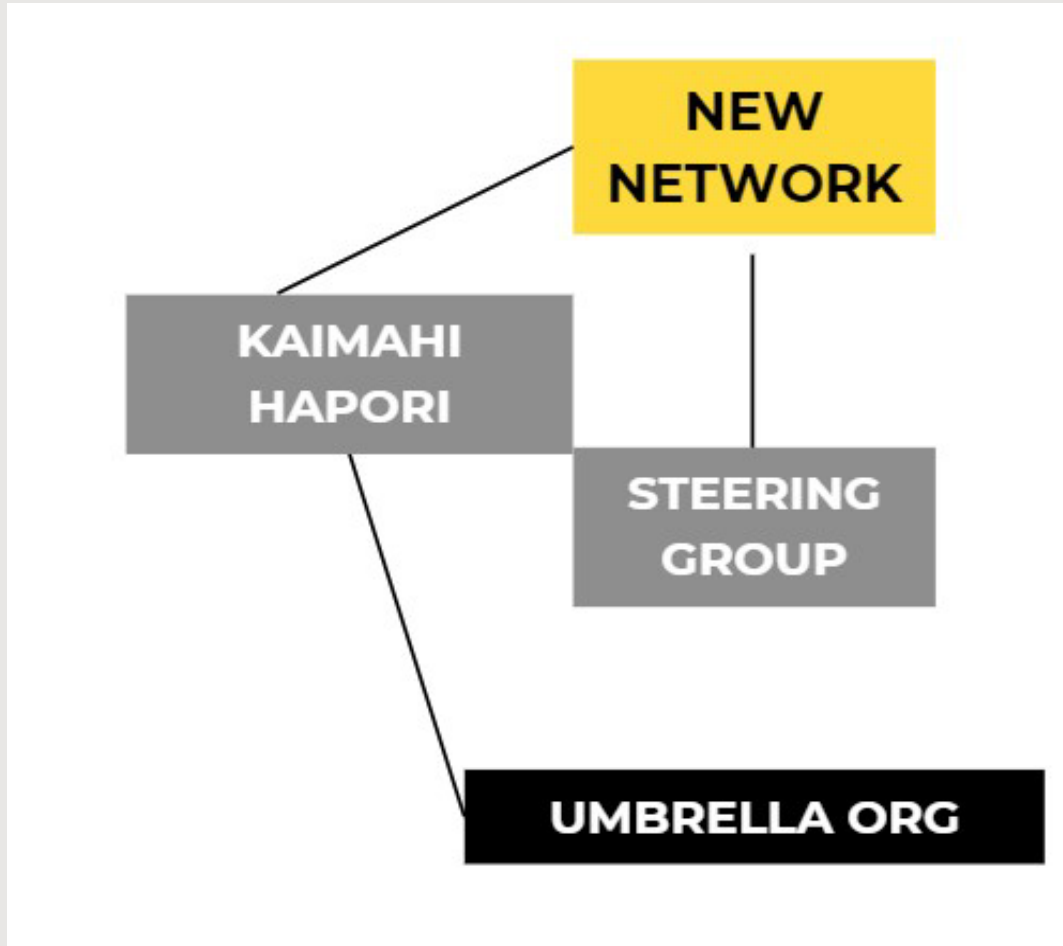

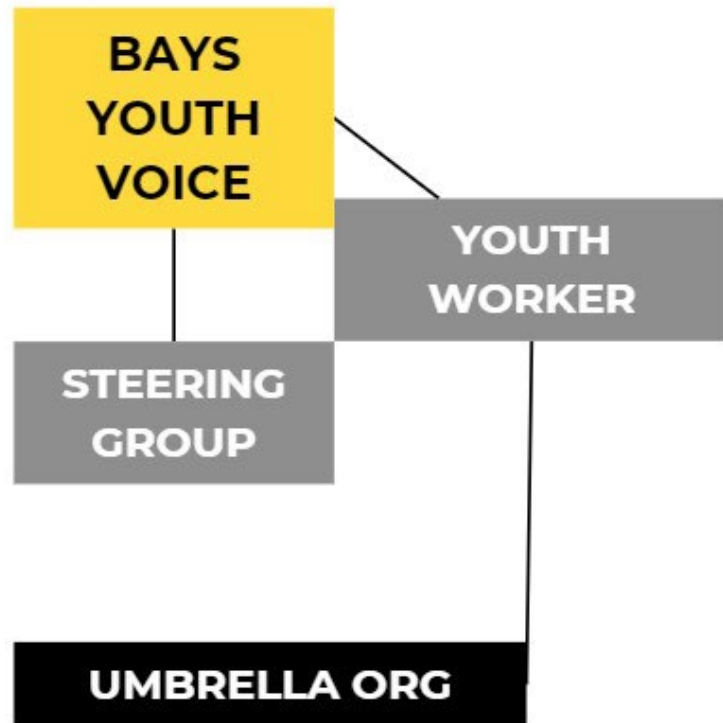
Developing clarity

- Purpose is to connect and strengthen the adults across an ecosystem – so the young people are better supported.



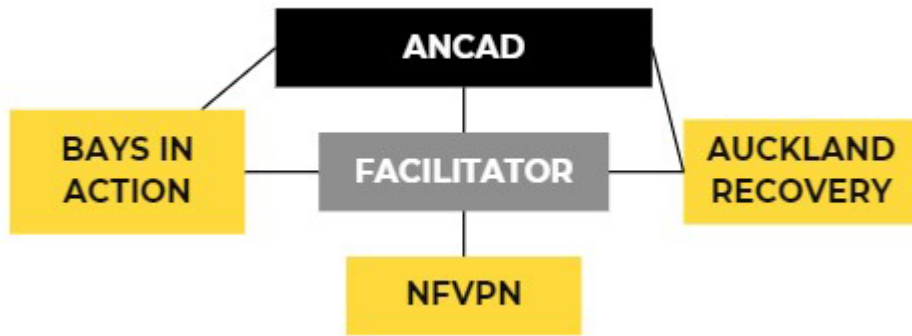
Bays Youth Voice
