



Pursuant to Section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) gives notice that it no longer requires part of designation 6705 included in the Auckland Unitary Plan (AUP).

This designation is for road widening purposes and extends 5m either side of designation 6704. In this case, the designation is located both immediately parallel to designation 6704 and also extends further into the affected properties in this location.

The designation is listed in Chapter K of the AUP and shown on the AUP e-plan maps. The purpose of the designation is: Land for road widening 5m where indicated on map 100, to a minimum width of 30m of road reserve.

The legal name for NZTA as a requiring authority is New Zealand Transport Agency. The name of the requiring authority for designation 6705 as listed in the District Plan is New Zealand Transport Agency.

A portion of the designation is no longer required on the land listed in Table 1 in Attachment A. The area of the designation to be removed is shown on the plan in Attachment B.

The part of the designation to be removed is no longer required for the on-going operation, maintenance or mitigation of effects of the work authorised by the designation. The balance of designation 6705 will be retained.

NZTA requests the Council amend the district plan accordingly as required by section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991.





Partial removal of Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening - Karaka to Pukekohe in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part).

Summary

Auckland Council has received a notice from New Zealand Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (**NZTA**) under section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (**RMA**), dated 24 July 2024, to remove in part Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening - Karaka to Pukekohe in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) (**AUP**).

A section 182(1) request is required to uplift the existing designation in part from land which has been deemed surplus by NZTA.

Auckland Council, as the territorial authority, is required to amend its district plan, without using the process in Schedule 1, as soon as reasonably practicable after receiving a Section 182 request unless it considers that the effect of the removal of part of the designation on the remaining designation is more than minor.

It is recommended that the partial removal be accepted.

Recommendation

- That the section 182 request from NZTA for the partial removal of Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening - Karaka to Pukekohe in the Auckland Unitary Plan be accepted for the following reasons:
 - The extent of the designation that applies to 763 Paerata Road, Pukekohe, Auckland (Pt Lot 3 DP 10780) and Paerata Road, Pukekohe Auckland, (Pt ALLOT 58 Parish Karaka District), is no longer required in respect of the NZTA's work programme for State Highway 22; and
 - The effects of the partial removal will not be more than minor.
- 2. That Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening Karaka to Pukekohe be partially removed from 763 Paerata Road, Pukekohe, Auckland (Pt Lot 3 DP 10780) and Paerata Road, Pukekohe Auckland, (Pt ALLOT 58 Parish Karaka District), as soon as reasonably practicable, in the Designation overlay in the Auckland Unitary Plan.

2.0 BACKGROUND

2.1 Details of designation

Designation 6705 applies to the extent of the State Highway 22 corridor (Karaka Road and Paerata Road) located between east of Woodlyn Drive, Karaka, and Adams Drive, Pukekohe. The purpose of the designation is recorded as "Land for road widening - 5m where indicated on Map 100, to a minimum width of 30m of road reserve".

In respect of the Karaka and Paerata areas, the designation extends approximately 5m on either side of designation 6704 of the State Highway 22 corridor from Karaka to Pukekohe.

2.2 Land affected by the removal

NZTA have advised that the part of this designation applying to 763 Paerata Road, Pukekohe, Auckland (Pt Lot 3 DP 10780), Paerata Road, Pukekohe Auckland, (Pt ALLOT 58 Parish Karaka District) and the road SH22, is no longer required. The advice is accepted.

NZTA have provided a site plan showing the extent of the designation which is to be partially removed (refer to Figure 3 or Attachment B in Waka Kotahi NZTA s182 Notice of Removal). The extent of the designation in the AUP and proposed partial removal are shown below.




Figure 1: Aerial map showing the affected sites, Designations 6704 and 6705, and surrounds (Source: Auckland Council GeoMaps)



Figure 2: Zoning map showing the affected sites, Designations 6704 and 6705, and surrounds (Source: Auckland Council GeoMaps)




Figure 3: Map showing the extent of partial removal of Designation 6705 (Source: NZTA)

2.3 Consultation

NZTA advise that the landowners of the properties affected by this removal have been notified and no other person is likely to be affected by the removal for the designation.

2.4 Delegated authority to consider alterations to designations

The Team Leader – Planning Central and South (Planning and Resource Consents Tier 5) has delegated authority, in accordance with Schedule 2A of the Auckland Council Delegations: Chief Executive's Delegations Register, Version 1.6, updated August 2024), to exercise the Council's functions, powers, duties and discretions under the Resource Management Act 1991 in relation to Section 182 to approve a removal of a designation.

The Team Leader, Craig Cairncross from Planning Central and South (Planning and Resource Consents Tier 5) is on leave and his delegation is redirected to the Manager (Celia Davison) – Planning Central and South (Tier 4).

Section 182 requests to remove a designation or part of a designation can, therefore, be considered by the Manager – Planning Central and South and accepted or declined.

2.5 Relevant Statutory Provisions

Section 182 of the RMA allows a requiring authority to remove a designation or part of a designation if it no longer considers it to be necessary. This section also applies to a notice

by a territorial authority, to withdraw its own designation or part of a designation within its own district.

Section 182(2) states that as soon as reasonably practicable the territorial authority shall, without using the process in Schedule 1, amend its district plan accordingly. If the territorial authority considers that the effect of the removal of part of a designation on the remaining designation is more than minor, it may, within 20 working days of receipt of a Section 182 notice, decline to remove that part of the designation.

It is considered that the NZTA has provided sufficient justification for the partial removal of Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening - Karaka to Pukekohe for the following reasons:

- The extent of the designation that applies to 763 Paerata Road, Pukekohe, Auckland (Pt Lot 3 DP 10780), and Paerata Road, Pukekohe Auckland, (Pt ALLOT 58 Parish Karaka District), is no longer required in respect of Waka Kotahi's work programme for State Highway 22; and
- The effects of the partial removal will not be more than minor.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

Pursuant to Section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 the partial removal of Designation 6705 State Highway 22 Road Widening - Karaka to Pukekohe be **ACCEPTED** and the Auckland Unitary Plan Operative in part designation overlay be amended accordingly.


